



## **NEW WORKER ON HOT MOP CREW**

1. Crew chief needs to train on:
  - a. How to safely handle kettles
  - b. Proper positioning and use of ladders
  - c. Warning tape area
  - d. When to wear safety glasses
  - e. The correct lifting & carrying positions, techniques
  - f. Proper temperature of kettle
  
2. On Roof:
  - a. Make aware of all danger areas
    - i. Bull & hot asphalt on deck.
    - ii. Penetrations
    - iii. Steep pitch, valleys of the roof & CAZ zone.
    - iv. Be aware of slippery surfaces of 30# & 90# if weather conditions are wet or damp. Such as overcast and rainy days.
    - v. PPE
    - vi. Look before throwing anything off the roof.
  
3. When Carrying Hot:
  - a. Only  $\frac{1}{2}$  to  $\frac{3}{4}$  full bucket.
  - b. Always make sure bucket is not sticking when lifting.
  - c. If stuck, twist bucket carefully, then lift slowly – don't jerk it
  - d. Pour hot only when mop is in bucket.
  - e. Use only one hand when pouring (pour from edge near handle)
  - f. Always wear gloves when using hot buckets.
  - g. Use face shield when pouring.
  - h. Be aware of:
    - i. Valleys
    - ii. PVC penetrations
    - iii. Loose and bent up tin tags.
  
4. Never be in a hurry!
